WHERE IS THE MISSION TRIP?

In the town of Altoona and the surrounding areas in the Alleghenies Mountains, mission trips allow youth to serve families and ministries in need through hands-on projects. These projects include painting, home repair, roofing and building wheelchair ramps. Local churches and missions will also be served during this mission trip as groups lend a hand to help maintain and improve their facilities, showing the love of Christ throughout an area in need.

WHEN IS THE MISSION TRIP?

We will be heading to Blue Knob, July 11-17, 2021.

Our plan is to leave in the late morning/early afternoon on Sunday, July 11.

We will return in the afternoon on Saturday, July 17.

WHERE ARE WE STAYING?

We will be staying at apartment-style College dorms at Penn State University, Altoona campus. Our housing location is in a beautiful mountain setting with plenty of outdoor recreation areas and hiking trails. All meals are provided, except two lunches and two dinners during free time.

WHAT IS REQUIRED FOR THE MISSION TRIP?

Students who would like to participate in this trip will need to fill out the appropriate attached paperwork and hand in correct payments on time.

Note: If you have filled out an Addisville Liability Form for H2O this past year, you do not need to fill out a new one.

Students will need to hand in:

- The \$225 registration fee
 - \$25 deposit to hold their spot BY March 28
 - \$200 remainder due BY June 1 (feel free to pay in installments)
- The Addisville Liability/Photo Release/Behavior Contract Form
- The TEAMEffort Permission Slip and Liability Form (this MUST be notarized)
